APRIL 2006 RECIPE

HAM AND OLIVE CASSEROLE 1 Ib. Ham Dices into Cubes 8 oz. Vermicelli 34 cup Parmesan Cheese Grated 1/3 cup Butter or Margarine 4-5 Mushrooms Sliced 3-4 Tbsp. Diced Onion 14 cup Flour 2 cups Lt. Cream 34 cup Dry White Wine 1/3 cup Sliced Green Olives 1/4 tsp. Oregano 1/8 tsp. Pepper or to taste

Cook pasta until done and drain, keeping warm. Mix with ½ cup parmesan cheese. Meanwhile, sauté mushrooms and onions in butter, then removing them and keeping the butter. Add flour and cream into butter until it thickens, then adding wine, olives, oregano, and pepper blending them in. Add ham and mushroom/onion mixture into the sauce until blended and pour over the pasta in a deep casserole dish, topping with remaining Parmesan cheese. Bake at 325 degrees until hot through and browning on top.
