

We will welcome Marcie Smith, Gaston County Environmental Analyst. She will present information about the new methane plant on Philadelphia Church Road and explain the use of biodiesel fuel in the Counties off road diesel vehicles. Following a two month trial period, the Gaston County Landfill will continue to use biodiesel for it's off road diesel vehicles. The Centralina Clean Fuel Coalition funded the pilot program with a grant from the NC State Energy Office. However, when the pilot program finished at the end of August, the decision was made to stay with the biodiesel B-20 which is 20% biodiesel mixed with 80%
