This will be an excellent opportunity for our folks to attend one of the largest and enjoyable shows. We will travel by chartered bus on the 26<sup>th</sup>, attend the show on the 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, and travel home on the 29<sup>th</sup>. We will be staying at Americas Best Value Inn in Celina, Ohio, 28 miles from the tractor show.
