Cotton Ginning Day Vendors and Exhibitors should note the following:

- Rope off area around your exhibition. You should keep display areas "pedestrian friendly"- giving our guests room to view exhibits. Never leave running equipment unattended.

- 3. Golf carts and other vehicles should be mindful of people walking around and not watching you!

If you are exhibiting only—this does not apply. In general if you are offering anything for sale during the festival-memorabilia, engine parts to crafts, etc- for vendor registration.
